Whistler Animals Galore Annual Report 2014

Dear friends of WAG.

WAG is a non-profit organization that has been serving our community for more than 30 years. Our purpose is to protect and enhance the lives of lost, unwanted, and homeless animals throughout the Sea to Sky corridor by operating a unique no-kill shelter that emphasizes animal welfare, enrichment, and respect for every animal in our care.

During 2014, WAG cared for over 300 animals; 170 animals were found or abandoned, while over 130 were surrendered. Through our adoption program, we coordinated the successful adoption of 127 animals.

Of the animals that came to WAG in 2014, over 25 were in need of critical care treatments costing more than \$15,000. Otto, a 12-year-old dog, was abandoned at the WAG shelter. A visit to the veterinary clinic revealed he had the worst case of dental disease ever seen. Following the extraction of 21 teeth, Otto's personality went from sad to happy and energetic. He could finally eat without his gums bleeding. Otto won the heart of a Vancouver woman who believes love has no age limit.



Otto's story is all too common. Many of the animals that come to WAG have histories of neglect. With the continued efforts of the WAG staff, our extraordinary volunteers, our sponsors, donors, adopters and the Resort Municipality of Whistler, Otto and hundreds like him are in their forever-loving homes.

On behalf of all the animals whose lives will be saved, we thank you.

#### **Notes to Financial Statements**

The overall income in 2014 saw a net increase of \$24,700 which will replenish our Critical Care savings account and provide a more solid basis for programs in 2015. 2014 saw a high number of animals in need of critical care treatments, with a year over year increase of over \$4,000. However this was offset by an increase in our fundraising efforts for these costs. Overall revenue saw an increase from the prior year, notably in Membership fees, and Coin revenues. WAG's main fundraiser event revenue was lower overall in large part due to a date change of the event. WAG started a new program for wellness clinics in Mount Currie, which was enabled by a grant from Paws for Hope animal foundation. Overall expenses saw a significant decrease from the prior year, especially in labour expenses. WAG is grateful for the discounted support it has received from the local veterinary clinics.

#### **WAG Services to Animals and the Community**

WAG provides a variety of services to our resident animals and to the community including the following:

- Providing shelter to abandoned, surrendered, lost cats and dogs
- Providing critical care veterinary treatments
- Providing socialization & training for cats and dogs
- Finding foster homes for recovering or kennel stressed animals
- Finding forever homes for ALL shelter animals
- Providing lost and found animal services
- Processing licenses and impound services
- Coordinating adoption programs
- Implementing volunteer programs
- Providing low cost spay and neuter programs
- Providing educational programs, animal visit and dog bath facilities

#### **Adoption Programs**

WAG's adoption program is based on a diligent matchmaking approach. In 2014 WAG coordinated the successful adoption of 127 animals. WAG also provides adopters with resources to understand the responsibilities of owning pets and tools to provide ongoing animal welfare.



#### **Community Initiatives**

Through education and awareness, WAG creates a safe and loving community for dogs, cats and people to enjoy together. In 2014, in conjunction with the Mt. Currie Band, Pemberton Veterinary Hospital, and the amazing support of the Resort Municipality of Whistler, WAG began a new program of animal wellness clinics. Over the course of four clinics, 69 animals were assessed by a veterinarian and 11 animals were spayed or neutered.


